Waddesdon Hall Winter Visit - Wednesday November 30th 2022

Kay has been working hard on this trip for some time now, trying to confirm numbers and organise transport!! As you can see the date is now confirmed and a minibus is about to be booked, however, there are still three places on the minibus and so there is a final opportunity to join the 13 of us who are already planning to go.

The cost of entry to the Hall for the full day is £7.50 if you are a member of the National Trust and £31.80 if you are not a member (almost worth becoming a member and making some visits to NT properties through the year!!). These prices include a group reduction.

The cost of the minibus and driver varies depending upon the number of passengers - for 13 of us it is 32.50 per person but it will obviously reduce if other members wish to come along.
